High quality documentation is the goal of the CDI process. By utilizing education and queries, CDI staff strive to accurately reflect the hospital stay and care rendered. This program provides education on updates from the most recent AHIMA guidelines, elements necessary for high quality documentation, and how to execute a successful query & education process to impact your organization. When documentation is lacking, the CDS or coder is tasked with engaging the provider to clarify the record often via a query. The query process is reviewed with emphasis on maintaining compliant practice from inpatient admission through post-discharge review. Elements of compliant practice in the outpatient setting are also briefly discussed.
